

Important Information

Accreditation



Exploring Leipzig

Gymnastics & Sports festivals in Leipzig – most locals associate these events with the “Zentralstadion” as “the” venue. It was built in the mid – 1950s with the help of over 180,000 volunteers. The walls of the stadium contained approx. 1.5 million cubic metres of World War II debris from Leipzig and the surrounding areas. Because of its capacity and the number of builders, it was also called the “Stadium of the Hundred Thousand”.

Until 1994, the “Zentralstadion” was used for a wide variety of sporting events. After that it was only used sporadically and to a limited extent. Partly because of its bad condition. From 2000 onwards, the stadium was almost demolished and a fundamental reconstruction took place.

In May 2002, the final gala of the German Gymnastics Festival took place while the stadium was still under reconstruction.

On the 16th and 17th of July 2004, the stadium was reopened as a football stadium. With RB Leipzig, the stadium has now a permanent host and was renamed to “Red Bull Arena” on the 1st of July 2010. However locals still refer to it as “Zentralstadion”.

We are looking forward to an unforgettable event with you.
